The following sample worksheet will help you calculate your total charges, which include tuition, fees, residence hall and board plan. Costs assume a double room in Biever or Buddig and the 15 Meal Plan. In order to accurately calculate the total credited amount derived from your financial aid, please refer to your Financial Aid Award or your Award Summary in Loyola Online Records Access (LORA).
