The Certificate in Editing and Publishing introduces students to the profession of editing and to the publishing industry. It is a transcript annotation that recognizes course work in English that prepares students for a career in publishing. It can be combined with progress toward a B.A. in English or another field.

Coursework

The Certificate in Editing and Publishing will be awarded for the completion of five courses, at least three of which must be from the list below. Up to two creative writing courses (listed further down) may count toward the certificate.
